## Audition Information

May 24<sup>th</sup> 6:30-8:30 and May 26<sup>th</sup> 2:30-4:30

### What to Do

- Prepare two minutes of song from a musical, set to accompaniment.
- Choose a song that shows off your range and ability, not necessarily one that matches the character for which you are auditioning.
- Perform your audition with confidence and lots of character.
- Memorize your audition piece. It is better to have 1 minute of memorized song than 2 minutes and paper in your hands.
- Plan to attend both audition days if at all possible (we understand if you cannot make it to both, it will not affect your eligibility).

### What to Bring

- Accompaniment for your audition piece (cd, youtube, thumb drive, etc).
- A positive, respectful attitude toward others.
- A willingness to be directed. We may stop you in the middle to restart or ask you to sing again based on our direction.
- Character, character, character, we cannot emphasize this enough.
- Confidence. This is the key to an effective audition, always.
- A list of any conflicts you have with the rehearsal period.

### What To Expect

- Please come at the start of the audition window to complete your audition form.
- There is no sign-up for specific time slots, auditioners are expected to stay for as much of the audition time as possible.
- We will be holding auditions as a group, everyone watching every other audition. If this is highly uncomfortable for you, please let us know, and we can arrange a more private audition.
- After Thursday's audition, we will be setting up for our karaoke fundraiser event (Thursday at 7 PM). Please plan on attending if possible.
